



GPEX Appeals Policy

Note

This policy commences on 1 January 2016 and will apply to all registrars in the GPEX training program under the Australian General Practice Training (AGPT) program.

1. Purpose

This policy sets out the circumstances under which a registrar may appeal a decision of the Grievance Management Committee (GMC) made in accordance with the *GPEX Grievance Policy*.

2. Scope of this policy

This policy applies to registrars enrolled in the GPEX training program.

3. Policy statement

3.1 A registrar may only appeal to the Department of Health Appeals Panel (Appeals Panel) in accordance with the *AGPT Appeals Policy 2017* after exhausting options under the *GPEX Grievance Policy*.

3.2 Only decisions made by the GMC can be reviewed under the *AGPT Appeals Policy 2017*.

3.3 GPEX will co-operate with any appeal process or request for further information when requested by the Appeals Panel in accordance with the *AGPT Appeals Policy 2017*.
